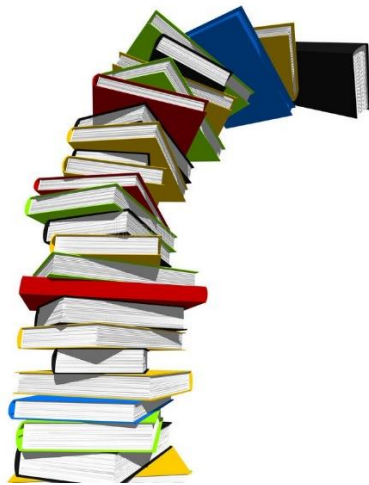


# Save Connecticard!
